



UMKC Honors Program Policy on Good Academic Standing

The UMKC Honors Program requires students to maintain a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA to remain in good academic standing. If a student's GPA falls below a 3.2, they will be placed on Honors Program Probation. Students on Honors Probation are still eligible to enroll in Honors courses.

Required GPA for University Honors

A cumulative GPA of 3.2 is required for graduation from UMKC with the distinction of University Honors.

Academic Progress

Students who are on Honors Probation will be evaluated at the end of each semester to ensure they have made sufficient academic progress toward the minimum 3.2 GPA. Once they have achieved a 3.2 GPA, students will be removed from the probationary status. Students who do not make sufficient progress toward good academic standing will be dismissed from the Honors Program after two semesters on probation. However, the Director of Student Services may authorize additional semesters of Honors Program Probation if a student is making steady progress toward good academic standing.

Academic Advising Expectations

While on Honors Program Probation, a student must meet with the Director of Student Services twice per semester (at least once before midterm). In order to keep priority registration for the current term, student must have one meeting in the first four weeks of the semester.
