Talbott Honors Program Scholarship Application



Overview

The UMKC Honors Program invites outstanding students of all majors to apply for the **Linda H. and Thomas H. Talbott Honors Program Scholarship**. Please read the eligibility requirements carefully to determine whether you are eligible to apply for this scholarship. Each annual scholarship award will be at least \$1,000. This scholarship may be awarded for a maximum of one year and is not renewable.

Eligibility Requirements

Talbott Honors Program Scholarship applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

- The selected recipient must be in the high need category of financial aid, as determined by UMKC's Office of Financial Aid. This determination will be based on the combined federal adjusted gross income of the student and the student's family, as reported on the FAFSA, consistent with federal financial aid regulations.
- The selected recipient must be a **Missouri resident** who is currently enrolled at UMKC.
- Annual scholarship awards shall be made only to students who are enrolled full-time at UMKC, meaning that they are enrolled in a minimum 12 academic credits in both fall and spring semesters during their tenure of the scholarship award.
- Preference shall be given to outstanding undergraduate students who are members in good standing of the UMKC Honors Program especially those who are enrolled in honors courses and actively engaged in Honors Program events and activities.

Before submitting your scholarship application, we recommend that you contact each faculty member you have listed to confirm that they are willing to provide a statement of support upon request. Be sure to explain that they do not need to submit a statement of support at this time; rather, the Honors Program will contact them in the next few weeks if a statement of support is needed. It would be courteous for you to provide each faculty member with a copy of your résumé and your UMKC transcript so they can be prepared to provide a well-informed statement on your behalf.
